CUBBIES



Cubbies is the AWANA Club for our 3 & 4 year olds. They participate in bible memorization, crafts, and they use the AWANA handbook. Cubbies receive AWANA rewards, and have AWANA activities. We also have story time, puppet shows, and lesson specific activity.

Truth & Training is our AWANA Club for 3rd, 4th, 5th, and 6th graders. Boys and Girls have separate classes.

Their club meeting consists of a Council Time (singing and bible teaching), a Handbook Time (small groups completing handbooks), and a Game Time, when games are played on the AWANA game circle.

Game Time

Kids love AWANA games. Individual and team competition takes place through circle games exclusive to AWANA. Game Time unleashes kids' enthusiasm and natural energy.

Handbook Time

Kids work one-on-one with a trained leader to complete assignments in the curriculum materials. AWANA emphasizes memorization and understanding of key Bible verses that show how to know God and walk with Him. A series of awards and trophies reward achievements at every level.

Awana Bucks



Awana points are awarded to the children for specific accomplishments (see below). All Awana Bucks can be redeemed at the Awana Christmas Store to purchase family gifts. The children may also use their Awana Bucks at the Spring Store for themselves.

NOTE: Teachers keep a point system for each class. Bucks are distributed on night of the store. Children do NOT have to keep up with their bucks, or points.
