Information of Interest

The Christian Life Center is approximately 20,750 square feet with 15,000 square feet on the first level and 28 foot eave height. The facility includes internet, indoor and outdoor security cameras, telephone, TV's, vending area, etc. There is also a covered entry area for drop off, a covered entry from the original sanctuary, as well as additional parking areas.

The gym includes a regulation size high school baskethall court as well as a regulation size volleyball court. In addition, the gym will also allow two regulation size cross court volleyball matches simultaneously or two cross court baskethall courts. The gym includes a center electric curtain/divider that will partition the court for safety when used with the cross court configuration. The gym includes a stage for use during various events that allows full access for handicap visitors or members. Folding bleachers are also included.

The facility includes a lobby for assembly, storage areas, office, welcome center, warming/catering kitchen, rest rooms, and a 100+ seat multi-purpose room (connected to the warming kitchen) to be used for functions such seminars, meetings, showers, conferences, etc.

The second floor of the building includes a 150+ seat youth room with stage, lighting, projection system, etc. The second floor includes a large multi-purpose room that can be used for various functions. In order to prevent any exclusion from participation; the second floor can be accessed with an ADA elevator/lift for wheelchair, elderly visitors, those who may be injured, and those who may have difficulty with stairs.

We believe that the entire church family will enjoy the Christian Life Center for many years. We pray that it will provide a place for caring, friendships, good times and fellowship. We trust that it will further allow the First Baptist Church of Saks to be a witness to our community and a tool to be used to lead others to know Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior.

All this was made possible because of the Lord's blessings as well as the cooperation, sincerity, dedication, and contributions provided by the members, and guests of the First Baptist Church of Saks.
