WAIT ON THE ALTAR

"Wait for the Lord; be strong and take heart and wait on the Lord." - Psalm 27:14 (NIV)

I'm impatient. There, I said it. My wife won't believe I just admitted to that even though she tells me all the time that I am. When we are doing a project, I want it finished. When we order something, I want it right away. I hate waiting on my birthday, Christmas, pay day, or even breakfast! I found my Christmas gift from my mom and dad one October and had to wait until Christmas to get it. That one about did me in. That may also be the cause of why I hate to wait.

There was a man in our church who sang a song written by Ray Boltz titled, "The Altar." I absolutely loved the song; therefore, I bought the track so I could sing it in revival services or banquets, things like that. I especially loved the song's message; it really touched my heart the first time I heard it.

Shortly thereafter, I was asked to do a Sunday through Friday revival at Cropwell Baptist Church in Pell City, Alabama. Our evangelist for the week was Bro. Emmett Roper. I prepared songs to use with the choir, I prayed for the meeting, and I picked out my special music for each night. "The Altar" was my favorite song, and I was planning to do it Sunday night. However, the Lord said, "Wait." Monday night, Bro. Emmett had invited someone to sing the special. Tuesday night, I was asked to sing "Beulah Land," a song written by Squire Parsons. Wednesday night, the choir performed the special music. Thursday night, I felt led to sing something else. Finally, Friday night arrived, and it seemed to be the right time to sing it. I led the congregation and then prepared to sing "The Altar" right before the message. Before it was time for my special, the pastor introduced Bro. Emmett. Something began to happen; I sensed a strong move of the spirit upon me like I hadn't felt all week. I had prayed so hard for God to use my song, but He hadn't let me use it until right then. He told me to wait because He wanted the right people to be there at the right time. It wasn't about me; I needed to wait on him. When the introduction to "The Altar" began to play, people started coming to the church altar to pray and make decisions for God. When I finished singing, people were still praying. Bro. Emmett instructed me to sing it again. I sang "The Altar" four or five times that night as deacons, a staff member's wife, Sunday school teachers, boys and girls, and men and women were being saved. It was the most powerful move of God I had ever experienced. Bro. Emmett never got to preach that night, but lives were changed forever as the spirit moved in that service. After the service Bro. Emmett said, "I love it when the Big Preacher shows up and shows out." It has been years since I last saw Bro. Emmett. Every time I do he asks me, "Do you remember that night at Cropwell when you sang "The Altar" for an hour and people just kept getting saved?" Yes Bro. Emmett, I do. I will never forget it. Today's scripture reminds us to be strong, take heart (be encouraged), and just wait on Him. He is never late, and He is always on time. Look, He is here now, standing at

the altar. Prayer: "Thank you, Lord, for your perfect timing in our lives.

If I will just learn to wait on You, You will make it worth the wait."
